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This in due time made this Thirtieth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven between Manly Bright of the District and State aforesaid Administrator deceased now with the will annexed of the goods and chattels rights and credits of L W Mayfield decd of the one part and B S Bright of the same state and District of the other part Whereas as most of summons to divide or sell a tract of land herein after described of the Estate of L W Mayfield of the said District decd issued from the Court of Ordinary of said District and upon the examination of the said land it was determined that it could not be divided without manifest injury to the parties interested but to be sold on a credit of twelve months with interest from the day of sale whereas the said Manly Bright did advertise the said lands for sale on the twelfth day of October in the year above mentioned and whereas the said Manly Bright as aforesaid did on the said day expose to sale at public outcry on the credit aforesaid the said land where the said B S Bright was the last and highest bidder to whom the said land was struck off for the sum of six hundred dollars.
