Moore as Com. missioner of the said Court after hearing duly advertised the said Land for sale by Public outcry on the first Monday of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty Eight did there openly and publicly and according to the Court's order of Auction sell and dispose of the said Land below described unto the said W B Johnson for Three thousand Dollars being at that price the highest bid for the same - Now therefore the said Court doth hereby order and by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars paid him by the said W B Johnson the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and released and by their presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said W B Johnson his Heirs and Assigns all that tract or lot of land situated lying and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid containing one hundred & sixty five acres more or less adjoining lands of Richard Goodlett deceased John Morris Marshall Shelton and others the said tract of land conveyed by John W. Ligon to A. C. Peace and from A. C. Peace to W A McCowen by Deed bearing date (30th) October 1866. Together with all and singular the Easements Rights Members and Appurtenances what so ever to the said Land belonging or in any wise appertaining and the Reversions and Remainders Residue Issues and Profits thereof and also all the Estate Right Title Interest Power Possession Property Benefit Claim and Demand whatsoever both at Law and Equity of the Heirs and Representatives of the said W A McCowen and of the parties to this deed and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof by force or under them or either of them to have and to hold the said Land unto the Heirs and

Assignments and Appurtenances unto the said W B Johnson his Heirs and Assigns to his and their only proper use and benefit and behoof forever in witness whereof the said James P. Together with all and singular the rights Members Easements and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appurtenances. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Alfred Davis his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Alfred Davis his heirs and assigns forever against me and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same on any part thereof.
