Moore shall be entitled to a lien on the crop which may be made during the year, upon the land in the culture of which the advances so made have been expended in preference of all other liens existing or otherwise to the extent of such advances or advances the said D. B. Moore has already made an advance to the said Wenderson Sullivan of three hundred and seventy two pounds of pork at 94 Cents per pound making in money twenty five dollars and six Cents the interest to be paid on the above from the 19th December 1867 this Contract to exist for the year 1868 Jan 11th 1868 Signed in presence of
