Nash who has been in service his and mine in fortune by the result of the late Civil War and are now in destitute circumstances as well as for the further consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Elizabeth P. Nash her heirs and assigns Executors Administrators and assigns all the right title claim interest and estate which may have accrued or accrued in any way by previous conveyances being that of the life estate of James P. Nash in and to that certain messuage parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in the County of Beaufort in the State of South Carolina bounded by waters of Port Republic River and parcel of land and house formerly owned and belonging to Dr. Thomas Fuller William Collette and Mrs. C. C. Verbin and known and designated as the Cottage containing two hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less which said tract or plantation or tract of land is now due and claimed by parties claiming title to the same from conveyances created under act of Congress during the late Civil War and are empowered to take possession of said premises by the same
