Thence South along Mrs Rogers line to a Hickory corner thence East to Clybon Mill Thence thence East along Joseph Hardins line to a pine corner on the Long Branch including all lands above the Cliffs thence up the Long Branch to Joseph McJunkins line said land containing fifty acres more or less all of which I forever grant release bargain and sell for the sum of Fifty Dollars in me in hand paid by Joseph McJunkin I hereby forever bind myself for his executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said land and premises unto the said Joseph McJunkin his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim all or any part thereof for ever and ever.

Between William Mc Thomas Esquire Commissioner of the Honorable Court for Greenville District at Greenville Court House in the said State of the one part and James Mc Cullough of the other part Thomas Nancy Hardin Head of a family on behalf the right then day of August

in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty which this bill of Complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House in the said State against Mary Jordan et al for the partition and sale of the Real Estate of Michael Jordan deceased. And the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at Chambers in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty when the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did order adjudge and decree that the said land for partition should be sold at Public Auction by the Commissioners of the said Court on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their decretal order as by reference thereto in the registry of the said Court well appear and the said William Mc Thomas of the said Court after having duly advertised the said land for sale by Public outcry on the fifth of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty did thereupon and according to the custom of Auctions sell and dispose of the said land below described unto the said James Mc Cullough for nine hundred and ninety nine dollars being at that price the highest bidder for the same. Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said William Mc Thomas as Commissioner of the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration of the sum of three Dollars paid him by the said James Mc Cullough the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and released and by this present doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said James Mc Cullough and to his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situated in Greenville District on Saluda River containing thirty four acre surrounded by the lands of G. W. French commencing at a Black Gum on the river 54 N 62 1/2 E 62.50 to a Hickory 3.111 N 86 1/2 E 24 to a Hickory 4.111 S 51 1/2 W 43.21 to a Willow 3.111 on the River thence along said river banks to the beginning corner Together with all and singular the hereditaments rights members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land belonging or in anywise appertaining and the reversions and remainders rents issues and profits thereof and also all the estate right title Interest dower possession property benefit claim and demand whatsoever both at law and equity of the heirs and representatives of the said Michael Jordan deceased and of the parties to this deed and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof by force or under them to have and to hold the said land with its hereditaments privileges and appurtenances unto the said James Mc Cullough and to his heirs and assigns to his and their only proper use benefit and behoof forever
