 seven hundred dollars paid to me by George W. French
 of said State and County have bargained & granted sell

and by these presents do bargain grant sell and Release unto
 the said George W. French his heirs and assigns all that Tract
 of Land situate in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid
 on the waters of Saluda River bounded by lands of the said George
 W. French containing ninety four acres more or less commencing
 on a black line on the Road 4+^m N 63 1/2° E 6200 a black line N 18
 & 12 3/4 to a black line N 11 & S 57 1/2° W 40 21 to a willow on the River then
 along said River bank to the beginning corner together with
 all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurten-
 ances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or apper-
 taining to have and to hold the above mentioned tract of Land
 containing ninety four acres more or less unto the said George
 W. French his heirs and assigns forever and I the said James
 M. Cullough do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors or admi-
 nistrators to warrant and forever defend the said tract of
 Land unto the said George W. French his heirs and assigns
