Perkins of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one thousand five hundred and twenty five Dollars to us paid by Miss Rosalie Turpin of Greenville County in the State aforesaid have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Miss Rosalie Turpin a certain tract piece or parcel of land situated in the County and State aforesaid on the East side of Reddy River containing one hundred and sixty (60) Acre more or less and having such bounds more or less as follows (viz) Beginning on a stream 3 <sup>rd</sup> on East bank Reddy River thence down the meander of said River to a State 3 <sup>rd</sup> on West side of said line thence N 57 <sup>th</sup> E 66 <sup>th</sup> W to a stream 3 <sup>rd</sup> on West side thence N 36 <sup>th</sup> W 15 <sup>th</sup> 00 to a stream 3 <sup>rd</sup> on West side thence N 54 <sup>th</sup> W 18 <sup>th</sup> 14 to the beginning corner it being a part of a tract formerly owned by Mrs Elizabeth Paul bounded by land of Dr W. B. Jones Mrs S. M. Jones Estate and G. W. Perkins and C. A.
