Styles a certain piece or parcel of Land containing one hundred and forty seven acres more or less situate lying and being in the County aforesaid on Enore River in being part of the tract when owned by Simon Styles beginning on the mouth of ditch N. P. Styles corner running thence N. 12 W. 83 chs to poplar st. thence N. 16 E. 9 chs to P. A. st. thence N. 5 E. 49 chs to Rock st. thence N. 50 E. 9 chs to Blk gum st. on an Long Branch thence down meanders of said Long Branch to Stake st. n. m. thence N. 89 W. 26 chs to Stake st. n. m. thence S. 2 1/2 E. 22 chs to Stake at the mouth of the ditch on Enore River thence up the meanders of said River to the beginning corner.
