B. Hall this wife Pamela G. Hall of Davis County, Mississippi and William Goldsmith of South Carolina Greenville County. Whereas the heirs of Thomas Goldsmith deceased did appoint William Goldsmith their agent to sell the real & personal estate of said deceased, and whereas said heirs did direct the said agent to sell a certain tract of land for cash hereinafter described, of the estate of Thomas Goldsmith deceased of said County deceased for distribution.
