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Whereas by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias issued out of the Court of common Pleas held for the County of Greenville, tested the eighteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven at the suit of Robert McRay Executor of the Estate of Alexander Norton deceased to me directed commanding me that of the goods and chattels lands and tenements of Dorcus Green to Levy the sum of Nine hundred Dollars damages & costs I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Dorcus Green all that certain piece parcel and tract of land containing Fifty Acres more or less situate and being in the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid about three miles from the City of Greenville and known in the survey made by William A Hudson D S on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of March 1869 as Lots 20 adjoining lands of John Keenan William Bates and lots Nos 18 & 21 for further particulars in plat attached. And whereas the said premises with their appurtenances since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned have been exposed to sale at public vendue and purchased by Dr Basil Manly of the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina for the sum of Four hundred and fifty five dollars being the highest sum that was bid therefor. Now know ye that I A B Vickers Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided. and for and in consideration of the said sum of Four hundred and fifty five Dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Dr Basil Manly the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Dr Basil Manly his heirs and assigns forever the said tract piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances and all the estate right title and interest which the said Dorcus Green of right had of in and to the same. To have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said Dr Basil Manly his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said A B Vickers might or ought to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said writ of Fieri Facias or otherwise
