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Whereas by virtue of a writ of fieri facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the County of Greenville tested the eighteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven at the suit of Robert McKay Executor of the estate of Alexander Norton Decd. to me directed commanding me that of the goods and chattels lands and tenements of Dorcus Green to levy the sum of Five hundred Dollars damages and cost I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Dorcus Green all that certain piece parcel and tract of land containing forty two acres more or less situate and being in the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina on the Laurens Road about two and one half miles from the city of Greenville and known as lot No 10 bounded by lots Nos 9, 13 and 14 for particulars of metes bounds and shape see plat made by W.A.
