This agreement entered into between David & Stradley of Greenville County and G. W. Goodwin Planter of Greenville County and State aforesaid Witnesseth that the said David & Stradley agree to furnish the said G. W. Goodwin from time to time during the present year two tons of Carolina Fertilizer at seventy five Dollars per ton to be used by the said G. W. Goodwin in the Cultivation of his Crops on his plantation known in Greenville County and State aforesaid or such other plantations as he may cultivate In Consideration of the same the said G. W. Goodwin does hereby sell transfer and agree to deliver to the said David & Stradley so much of the Cotton or other products of his plantations during the present year upon the gathering of said crop or any part thereof as will be sufficient to pay or satisfy them for the advances thus made, which transfer and conveyance is intended to create in favour of said David & Stradley the lien given by and made the act of the Legislature entitled an Act to secure advances for agricultural purposes approved and ratified on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D. 1866 and is intended to be a lien binding the Crops raised during the present year on said plantation or plantations in preference to all other liens or claims existing or otherwise to the extent of such advances aforesaid within the power rights and remedies by the said Act provided. And it is further agreed that the claim for the fertilizer furnished under this agreement shall be due and owing at the date of delivery of said fertilizer or parts thereof and that the lien hereby created shall and exist and take effect upon the said crop or parts thereof as the same shall be gathered to the extent of the value of fertilizer thus furnished and that the taking of a negotiable note or other security shall not discharge the immediate enforcement of the said lien whenever the said David & Stradley may deem it necessary and the said G. W. Goodwin covenants that he has not any time heretofore given to any person or persons

whichever may give upon the crop to be raised upon the said plantations or plantations during the present year and it is further agreed that the said G. W. Goodwin will pay interest on the value of the said fertilizer at the rate of one and half percent per month from the date on which the said fertilizer is furnished &c. witness my hand this day at my house & seal this the nineteenth day of January A.D. 1870
