of the sum of Five hundred and ninety Dollars to me
by William McKinnery Sr of Greenville County in the State
aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
the said William McKinnery his heirs and assigns a
certain tract of land lying and being in the County &
State aforesaid on Meadow fork a branch of Bush Creek
adjoining lands of Wm McKinnery Jr and others begin-
ning on a stake near the wagon road running west 55.00
to a post out 74 thence S 42.75 E to a stone the corner of
Wm Calloway land and the 76.00 place thence a straight
line to the corner made between Daniel McKinnery to
the corner made between Daniel McKinnery & William McKinnery
thence N 40 E to the Ridge road on Wm McKinnery Jr line
thence along said road to a corner of Wm McKinnery Jr
thence to the beginning stake on the original line contain-
ing one hundred and six acres more or less also all my
interest in and to a certain tract of land lying and being
in Greenville County in the State aforesaid known
as the July Brown road tract of land adjoining lands
of Wm McKinnery Jr Alfred Turner and others being
the tract of land sold by William Barton to Thomas
Calloway for particulars see Book 28 page 314 in the

and no cents to me in hand paid by John B Armstrong
and and Co aforesaid have granted bargained sold and
released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and
release unto the said John B Armstrong his heirs and assigns
all that parcel and tract of land situated and being
in Greenville County on the head branch of Reddy Fork
waters of Reddy River and hath such four marks and
boundaries as follows (viz) Beginning at a Spanish Oak
34 Corner and running S 2 1/2 W 11.35 to a black oak 34 corner
bounded by lands belonging to J L Woodside thence N 19 W
46.85 to a stake 34 corner thence S 72 W 5.40 to a white 34
corner bounded by lands belonging to J J Bennett thence
S 71.32 W 14.75 to a stake 34 corner bounded by lands be-
longing to J J Bennett thence S 15 W 27.70 to a white 34 corner
bounded by lands belonging to Samuel Charles and James
Mc David thence S 65 E 8.00 to the beginning Spanish Oak
34 corner bounded by lands belonging to J L Woodside
and containing one hundred and twenty six acres
or the land more or less together with all and singular
the rights members conditions and appurtenances
