 William & Whitman Esq. on Crop This indenture entered into between Williams & Whitman of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid of the one part and L. J. McWhite of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that whereas the said Williams & Whitman as aforesaid have by their presents agreed to make advancements to the said L. J. McWhite for agricultural purposes not to exceed two thousand Dollars during the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy now the said L. J. McWhite hereby agrees to give unto the said Williams & Whitman as aforesaid a Lien for the amount which shall be advanced with interest thereon at the rate

of Ten per centum per annum on all the crops of whatsoever description he may grow or cause to be grown during the year aforesaid on the farm or plantation of Mrs. F. C. Benson in the County and State aforesaid in accordance with the act of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina entitled an act to secure advancements for agricultural purposes, ratified the twentieth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty six, and it is further agreed by and between the parties as aforesaid by their presents that the said L. J. McWhite for himself his executors administrators and assigns does hereby consent promise and agree to and with the said Williams & Whitman as aforesaid that all the crops of whatsoever description reared and grown by him shall not be removed from his said farm or plantation without the written consent of the said Williams & Whitman as aforesaid and that if the aforesaid amount of advances as aforesaid shall not well and truly be paid by or before the twenty fifth day of November next it shall and may be lawful for the said Williams & Whitman as aforesaid on the survivor of them if either of them should die before the date and at any time after the 25<sup>th</sup> day of November next peaceably and quietly to enter into any or all the messuages lands or tenements of the said L. J. McWhite and to take into their custody or the custody of the survivor of them if either should die and the same to hold and detain to their own use and behoof so that they may sell and dispose of said crops of whatsoever description at their pleasure returning the overplus if any should happen to be after paying off the above mentioned sum of unto themselves the said Williams & Whitman as aforesaid unto the said L.
