Whereas Susana Threlkeld by next friend, on or about the eighteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty eight exhibited her bill of complaint in the Circuit Court at Greenville Court House in the said State, against W D Threlkeld administrator et al and the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at January Term in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty nine when the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did order adjudge and decree that the Lot of Land of the real estate of Lewis Rodgers represented by plat No 1 in the return of the Commissioners, and containing forty nine and one half acres should be settled upon Mrs Susan Threlkeld Clerk of the said Court on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their former order, and by reference thereto in the registry of the said Court will appear Now therefore this indenture witnesseth that the said William A M Daniel Esquire as Clerk of the said Court under and by virtue of the said decree and in consideration of the sum of

three Dollars paid him by the said Susan Threlkeld the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained sold and released and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said Susan Threlkeld to her sole and separate use and behoof during her natural life free from the debts contracts or liabilities of her present or future husband, and after her death to the issue of her body living, all that tract of land containing forty nine and one half acres more or less on Rudy River and having such metes & bounds as are represented upon a plat made by W A Hester Esq. the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January A D 1869 & herewith attached together with all and singular the hereditaments rights franchises and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Tract of Land belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the reversions and remainders unto Susan and profits thereof and also all the estate right title Interest Down possession property benefit claim and demand whatsoever both at Law and in Equity of the heirs and representatives of the said Lewis Rodgers and of the parties to this deed, and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same on any parts thereof by from or under them, or either of them, to have and to hold the said Tract of Land with its hereditaments privilege and appurtenances unto the said Susan Threlkeld for life with remainder to the issue of her body her and theirs only proper use benefit and behoof forever
