 Lesters corner thence N 77 1/2 E 30 ch to Black oak down thence S 2
 E 11 ch to a Pine thence N 39 E 5 ch. To a chestnut on the north side of
 the creek thence N 37 E 4.40 to a pine thence N 20 W 7 to a Black
 oak on the ridge road thence down said road to a Black oak Thomas
 Campbells corner thence S 12 E 18 ch to two perpendiculars thence S 15
 E 40.50 to a pine on William Stewarts line thence with said Stewarts
