as follows: Beginning on a Poplar 3+0 thence N 89. 6/18.00 to State  
3+ in Road, thence N 47. W 23.25 to a chestnut oak 3+0 thence S 41 20 12.00  
to Sweet Gum 3+ in a small branch, thence up said branch S 4 1/2  
E 10.00 to the beginning corner, Being a part of a tract of land  
conveyed to the said L. J. Hudson Sr by Thomas O. Lowndes and from  
Levi Howell to John Pike was granted to the said Levi Howell  
January 3<sup>rd</sup> 1824. Together with all and singular the rights Members  
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging  
or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and  
singular the premises before mentioned unto the said J. M. Chandler  
his heirs and assigns, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs
