 five (125) Dollars to me paid by Rev. E. S. Bunt of Greenville
 County in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold
 and released and these presents do grant bargain sell
 and release unto the said Rev. E. S. Bunt a certain lot piece
 or parcel of Land situate in the County and State aforesaid
 on the Pendleton Road about and about fourth mile from
 Greenville C. H. Containing three and one half (3 1/2) acres more
 or less and hath such bounds marks &c. as follows
 Beginning at the N. W. Cor of said Bunt's Lot - on which
 the north line thence N 70 W 6.10 to a stake 2 1/2 small 2.0
 3/4 thence S 21 1/2 W 5.55 to a stake 3/4 on north side Pendleton
 Road thence S 79 1/4 E 6.25 to stake 3/4 thence N 21 1/2 E 5.55 to
 the Beginning being a part of the tract of land I
 purchased of Alex. Miller and the same on which he
 lived bounded by lands of Mrs. S. M. Miller Capt. S. Stradley
 Sandy Miller West and Lake C. S. Bunt together with all
 and singular the rights tenements hereditaments and
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
