Coleman and Hardy Clark the devise aforesaid by and with the consent of Henry C. Young one of the Executors of said will to sell the said tract of land and substitute the proceeds of said sale in lieu thereof the interest thereon to be paid to the said Amelia Coleman during her natural life the principal to be distributed as directed by the will of the said John T. Coleman Now know all men by these presents that the said James M. Coleman Amelia Coleman and Hardy Clark Executors aforesaid under the will of the said John T. Coleman and Henry C. Young Executor of said will in consideration of the sum of four thousand six hundred and fifty dollars secured to be paid by Dr. Thomas Sykes of Fairfield District in the State aforesaid have bargained sold released and conveyed and by the presents do bargain sell release and convey unto the said Thomas Sykes all that tract or parcel of land being upon Mountford situated lying and being in the District of Greenville and about one mile and a fourth from Greenville Village in the State aforesaid containing Seventy six and an half acres and upon which the late John T. Coleman formerly resided and the said Amelia Coleman now resides and having such shape marks and boundaries as the plot annexed to this deed represents together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging in and law incident to appertaining to hold and to hold in and to hold unto the said Thomas Sykes his heirs and assigns forever
