paid by Charles P Reunion of Greenville County in the
State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
unto the said Charles P Reunion all that tract parcel
or Plantation of Land ~~adjoining~~ adjoining lands of G P Dill Jells A
Turpins Estate N G ~~estate~~ estate William McKinnis and others
containing One Hundred and Twenty four & a half acres
More or less being composed of two tracts one bought of Francis
Green and the other from J M A Turpin being a small piece
on Fox branch exchange for a small piece on a branch of Sumner
River. Together with all and singular the Rights Members heredi-
taments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in
any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Charles
P Reunion his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby
bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto
the said Charles P Reunion his heirs and assigns against my
self and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

27th day of September 1866 conveying tracts of land situate
lying & being in Greenville County State of South Carolina

containing Four Hundred and Sixty four and a half acres more or
less on South Sugar & Mush Creek bounded by lands of Mc
Mellon Cannon Taylor & others the other tract to W P Green
on the meadow Fork Creek & Mush Creek containing two hund-
red & eighty four and a half acres more or less adjoining lands
of ~~James~~ Laylor & Forrest & others and also to take the
renunciation of E Louisa Lodd wife of Samuel H Lodd
of the State of Texas of her dower in the premises described
in the deed from Samuel H Lodd to L H Shumate & J P
Perry dated the 1st day of August 1870 conveying a tract
of land situate lying & being in Greenville County State of
South Carolina on South Sugar River & Mush Creek conta-
ining Four Hundred & Sixty four and a half acres more or less
bounded by lands of McMillen Taylor & Cannon & others
Also to take the renunciation of Minerva A Green wife of W
P Green of the State of Texas of her dower in the premises
described in the deed from W P Green to L H Shumate & J P
dated 1st day of August 1870 conveying a tract of land situa-
te lying & being in Greenville County State of South Carolina
on the meadow Fork Creek & Mush Creek containing Two Hundred &
eighteen four and a half acres more or less bounded by lands
of James Taylor & Forrest. For these purposes you will cause
the said Susan Barnett E Louisa Lodd & Minerva A Green
to appear before you & you will examine them separately & apart
apart from each other & apart from all other persons and
if upon their examination they shall each on freely declare
that they do freely voluntarily and without any compulsion
