 thousand eight hundred and seventy did exhibit  
 her petition in the Court of Probate at Greenville  
 Court House in the County of Greenville and  
 State aforesaid against Alfred Hornum et al  
 praying that the Real Estate of Isaac Beinfeld  
 be sold for the payments by debt of said dead  
 And the Cause being at issue before the honorable  
 Court aforesaid came on the heard on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of  
 in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred  
 and seventy when the said Court after full hearing  
 thereof and mature deliberations in the premises  
 did order and decree that the Real estate  
 of said dead should be sold at Public auction by  
 the Sheriff of Greenville County South Carolina  
 on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in  
 the decretal order in the said Cause as by reference  
 to the laws in the Registry of the said Court will  
 appear And the said A. B. Vickens as Sheriff as  
 aforesaid having duly advertised the said Real  
 Estate for sale by the Public auction on the 5<sup>th</sup> day  
 of September in the year of our lord one thousand  
 eight hundred and seventy did then openly and  
 publicly and according to the custom of auctioneers  
 sell and dispose of the said Real Estate as below described  
 unto the said Sarah A. Beinfeld for the sum of  
 sixty dollars she being at the price the highest  
 bidder for the same Now therefore this indenture  
 witnesseth that the said A. B. Vickens as Sheriff as  
 aforesaid under and by virtue of the said decree  
 and in consideration of the sum of sixty dollars to  
 him paid by the said Sarah A. Beinfeld the  
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath  
 granted bargained sold and released and by these  
 presents doth grant bargain sell and release  
 unto the said Sarah A. Beinfeld by her and  
 assign all that tract of land situate in  
 Greenville County in the State aforesaid in  
 of more River adjoining lands of Henry Dorley  
 of Cream Hill and other and certain of

twenty five acres (more or less) together with all and  
 singular the Rights Members Hereditaments and appurtenances  
 to the said tract of Land belonging on in any wise  
 incident or appertaining and the Possession and  
 remainders rents issues and profits thereof and also  
 all the Estate Right title interest down possession  
 propriety Benefit claim and demand whatsoever  
 both at law and in Equity of the heirs and representatives
