E. R. Chapman to E. H. Hamilton	Lien on Crop	State of South Carolina Greenville County This agreement entered into between
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E. H. Hamilton of the one part and E. R. Chapman of the other part
 all of the State aforesaid. Witnesseth that the said E. H. Hamilton as
 aforesaid has furnished to the said E. R. Chapman from time to time
 during the year of 1868, 1869 & 1870 Merchandise to the amount of
 \$231 & two hundred & thirty one ⁴⁷/₁₀₀ Dollars for the subsistence of himself
 & family. In consideration whereof, the said E. R. Chapman does
 hereby sell transfer and agree to deliver to the said E. H. Hamilton
 so much of the cotton or other produce raised by the cotton or
 other produce raised by him during the present year upon the
 gathering of said crop or any part thereof as will be sufficient
 to pay or satisfy the said E. H. Hamilton for advances there made
 which conveyance or transfer is intended to create in favor of said
 E. H. Hamilton the lien given by and under the act of legislation
 entitled an act to secure the advances for agricultural purposes
 approved & ratified on the twentieth day of September A.D. 1864
 and is intended to be a lien binding the crop of said E. R. Chapman
 raised during the present year in preference to all other liens or
 claims existing or otherwise to the extent of such advances
 aforesaid with all the powers rights & remedies by the said act
 provided and it is further agreed that the claim for advances
 made shall be due & owing on the first day of February A.D. 1872
 and that the lien here created shall arise & take effect
 upon the said crop or part thereof as the same shall be gathered
 to the extent of advances made or that may be made during present year
