J. Medlock also two same mules (one horse the other a mare mule) about ten years old one two horse wagon one buggy and harness four head of stock cattle twelve head of stock of hogs and five head of sheep on the part of E. R. Ridgeway to have and to hold all and singular the said property together with the future issue and increase of the same unto the said Louisia C. Bolling her Executors administrators and assigns forever Provided nevertheless and it is expressly agreed between the parties aforesaid that of the said N. J. Medlock & Co. R. Ridgeway their Executors or administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Louisia C. Bolling her certain attorney Owen Administrators or assigns the full sum of five hundred and twenty five dollars with interest thereon from the first day of January last as fully appears by a note given by them bearing even date with this and signed by themselves with their names the above and foregoing Bill of Sale and every article and thing therein contained shall cease to be utterly void or else remain in full full force and virtue signed sealed this 11th March 1871
