released and by these presents do grant bargain sell  
and release unto the said B. F. Perry all that tract or  
parcel of Land situate lying and being on Marsh  
Creek in Greenville County and State of South Carolina  
containing forty three acres at ten dollars per acre  
being a part of the Taylor tract of Land purchased by  
me at Sheriff Sale and lie in part of the old Bonnett  
House now own by the said Perry Beginning at a  
Poplar corner at the foot of the Branch running thence  
with the road leading to the State road N 13 1/2 E 180 to a  
Black corner on line of the Road thence 66 E 5 1/2 to a stake  
in the Road thence W 72 1/2 E 12 1/2 to a stone in Road at the  
corner of lot belonging to Perry thence S 77 E 20 25 to a
