This Agreement this
day made and entered into between W. C.
Corle & J. C. Nichols witnesses that Nichols is to erect a house
as herein after described at a designated point on some
vacant lot on Washington Street the house fifty by twenty five
feet and fourteen feet high is to be built with the end of the
street planked up and covered covered with shingles to have
a tongue & gored floor and the standing in the front end
is to be used so that hereafter a door & window like the
Perkins Store can be put in Corle is to provide sash for
two windows in the back end and any others which Nichols
puts in he may remove Corle is to furnish all material
and have the fellows built as soon as they can be procured
and as soon as furnished the building is to be put up &
for them services Corle is to allow Nichols one hundred &
twenty five dollars on the out or hereafter stated Corle
pays the building to Nichols for two years from the 1st
of January next at one hundred and fifty dollars per annum
to be granted in advance the one hundred and twenty five dollars
to be deducted from the payment
