The land hereby conveyed being cut off and a portion of a certain piece parcel or tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid adjoining lands of Maria Green James Huber L. Vaughn and others being the same tract left me by my husband and purchased by him from George Greer. To have and to hold said tract or parcel of land unto said Atlanta & Richmond Air Line Railway Company for railroad purposes forever in fee simple
