In consideration of the profits and advantage to be arising by the construction of the Atlanta & Richmond Air Line Railway as well as the receipt of Five Dollars to me paid I have this day bargained and sold and do hereby transfer and convey unto the Atlanta & Richmond Air Line Railway Company and its successors and assigns all the land contained within one hundred feet in width on each side of the track or roadway measuring from the center of any portion of the lot of land hereafter described through which said Railroad may be constructed and operated. The land hereby conveyed being cut off and a portion of a certain piece parcel or tract of Land in the County and State of South Carolina lying on the Cox Bridge Road leading to Pickens about the middle of Greenville County. To have and to hold said tract or parcel of land unto said Atlanta & Richmond Air Line Railway for purposes here in full simple.

Now the above obligation in back that if the above named Perry Ashbury do truly make or cause to be made payment of ten thousand dollar given to said Isaac Newton amounting to fifty dollars each one of them payable 21st July 1872 the other payable 1st Nov 1872 with interest that may accrue there on the note being date the 22nd Nov 1871 if said Perry Ashbury do pay or cause to be paid said notes as they become due then the obligation and mortgage on the above horse is null & void other wise is full force of Law
