In consideration of the benefit and advantage to me accruing by the construction of the Atlanta & Richmond Air Line Railway as well as the receipt of Five Dollars to my said I have this day bargained and sold and do hereby transfer and convey unto the Atlanta & Richmond Air Line Railway Company and its successors and assigns all the land contained within one hundred feet in width on each side of the trace or roadway measuring from the center of any portion of the lot of land shown on the described through which said Railroad may be constructed and operated the land hereby conveyed being part of and a portion of a certain piece parcel or tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid and about one and one half mile from Greenville Court House and known as my farm Provided I am entitled to the wood on the land that the said Railway Company shall keep always the cattle track in good repair at whatever parts the said Railway crosses a fence and further if the said Atlanta and Richmond Air Line Railway Company or its successors or assigns should at any time be allowed any home of any description to be constructed on the said land hereby conveyed then
