This Indenture made the 12th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty one between George W. Shackleton of the one part and Robert League of the other part witnesseth that the said George W. Shackleton is fully indebted to the said Robert League in the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars by face note due and payable as follows first note due the 1st day of January 1873 for one thousand Dollars with interest at ten per cent per annum second note due 1st January 1874 third note due 1st January 1875 and the fourth note due 1st January 1876 each for one hundred Dollars and at the rate of ten per cent per annum the same being for the balance of the Purchase money for a tract of land hereinafter described and Mortgage to secure the balance of the Purchase money Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said George W. Shackleton for and in Consideration of the sum of Five Dollars to the said George W. Shackleton by the said Robert League in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents have granted bargain sold and released and do hereby grant bargain sell and release unto the said Robert League all that certain piece parcel and tract of land lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid containing one hundred and two Acres and one half be the same more or less Beginning on a Rock or Stone N 17 1/2 deg (224) to a Rock or Stone S 71 1/2 deg (200) feet to a Rock or Stone S 18 1/2 deg (60) feet to a Rock or Stone S 71 1/2 deg (200) feet to the Beginning Rock adjoining lands of J. H. Gorm and W. Goldsmith and others Together with all and singular the right Members Hereditaments & Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining I have and do hold out and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Robert League his heirs and assigns joined And I do hereby bind my heirs executors & administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Robert League his heirs and assigns against me & my heirs and against any person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Provided always nevertheless and in the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents that if the said George W. Shackleton his heirs executors or administrators shall and they pay or cause or cause to be paid unto the said Robert League by some of Seven Hundred Dollars and Interest according to the said note above mentioned then and from thenceforth these presents shall be utterly null & void and nothing herein contained to the contrary stand in any wise notwithstanding And it is Covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties
