Dill and the tract of Land belonging in to the Estate of H. H. Harrison dec'd and others Beginning on a State see the bounds of the Runabout Road thence more or less to a Sowerwood being nearly South to a Chestnut oak thence more or less to a Sowerwood thence more or less to a North thence down the Runabout Road to the Beginning Corner Containing by Estimation Seventy five acres more or less Together with all and singular the right Membrs Hereditaments and appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John P. Moore his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto John P. Moore his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs or any other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand seal this twenty ninth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven and in the 93rd year of the Liberty and Independence of the United States of America
