two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by J. B. Mathews
of Greenville County and in the state aforesaid have granted
Bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant
Bargain sell and Release unto the said J. B. Mathews the
forth part of or one share of the Garrison Mill Tract of land
and the one forth of the machinery belonging to said tract
of Land containing two hundred and six acres with the
Grist-Mill saw mills and Wool Carding the said land situated
lying and being Pickens County and Greenville County &
State aforesaid on both sides of Saluda River and Branches
of said River the first tract situated Pickens County State
aforesaid Beginning at Chingfield 3,380 m on the west Bank
of Saluda River thence S 62° E 45,570 ft to branch oak 3,380 m on
the Little Branch thence up the various meanders of said
Branch to the Rock State 3,380 m thence up the left branch fork
to Red oak 3,380 m down at the head thence S 78° W 0,750 ft to Pine
