 to the Honorable the Justices of the Supreme Court
 of the said State of South Carolina
 Know all men by these presents
 that I Thomas Chandler of Newberry District in the
 State of South Carolina in consideration of three hundred and
 seventy five dollars to me paid by Abram Collins of
 Greenville District in the State of South Carolina have granted
 bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant
 bargain sell and release unto the said Abram Collins
 all that piece parcel and tract of Land conveyed by Charles
 Dyer to Henry Dyer and by Henry Dyer to the said Thomas
 Chandler containing Sixty seven acres more or less lying
 situate and being in Greenville District in the State of South
 Carolina Branch of River dam Creek water of South Lager
 River adjoining lands owned by Abram Wilson J. P.
 Goodlett Samuel Dill Chigathick Dico and myself and being
 the following lines buttines and boundaries according
 to a plat of the same made by Washington Taylor J. P.
 and Certified to February fifth 1850 Beginning at white
 oak 3 1/2 ft in girth 1/2 W 25 1/2 Chs to Post oak 3 1/2 ft in
 girth S 13 W 15 1/2 Chs to a Chestnut 3 1/2 ft in girth S 16 E
 7 1/2 Chs to a light wood Stake 3 1/2 ft in girth S 8 1/2 E 18 0 Chs
 to Spanish oak 3 1/2 ft in girth S 6 1/2 E 8 3/4 Chs to an oak 3 1/2
 ft in girth by the Bank of the Branch then down the windings
 of the Branch to the Beginning. Together with all and
 singular the rights appurtenances and appertinances
 to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident
 or appertaining to the said premises to have and to
 hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto
 the said Abram Collins his heirs and assigns forever
 And I do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns and
 administrators to warrant and defend all and singular
 the said premises unto the said Abram Collins his heirs
 and assigns myself my heirs and assigns and every other person or
 persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
 same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this
 twenty second day of December in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and fifty and in the eighty fifth
 year of the Independence of the United States of America
 Signed sealed and Delivered in the presence of
 J. P. Chandler
 Middleton Seiber Thomas Chandler Seal
 of the Carolina Personally appeared before me
 Greenville District J. P. Chandler and there and
 that he saw Thomas Chandler sign seal and deliver
 the within deed for the uses and purposes therein stated

and that Middleton Seiber together with himself in the presence
