C. Brown his Successors and assigns forever all my rights title interest and property in or to all that parcel or tracts of Land containing two Hundred and thirty acres more or less situate lying and being on waters of Saluda River in Greenville County adjoining Lands of Aaron Humphreys L. Lusk and Dr. John Dean and being the same tract of Land conveyed to me by W. W. Humphreys as Commissioner by Equity for Anderson County by deed bearing date the twenty second day of October 1868 have and to hold all and singular the above described premises with the appurtenances unto the said W. C.
