Watson of Greenville County in the State of South Carolina have granted granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Robert P. Watson All that piece or parcel or tract of Land containing one Acre and a half and one half Acre in the same more or less situated in Greenville County and in the State of South Carolina on the East Side of Ruddy River there same lying part of a Tract originally granted to James Rushford the first day of October One thousand Seven hundred and ninety two the same was originally Surveyed for Robert Price the second day of February one thousand Seven hundred and eighty eight Beginning at a Stake at the Bridge on Ruddy River thence N 68° E 120 Ch to Stake 373 m in the Road thence N 89° E 380 Ch to Stake in said Road thence S 45° 4' E 600 Ch to Stake in said Road thence N 79° 3/4 E 124 Ch to Pine 373 m on said Road thence N 30° E 27.46 Ch to Pine 373 m on thence N 15° 1/4 E 2033 Ch to Stake 373 m formerly Black Lake or on gone old Pasture thence N 21° E 800 Ch to Stake 373 m in old Road thence N 65° Ch to Small Chestnut 373 m near old field thence S 65° W 24.00 Ch to Stake 373 m in field thence S 11.50 Ch to Pine 373 m on Rays Line of Grant thence N 167° 10 Ch to Stake 373 m on Small Red oak 373 m in each thence S 23° W 220 Ch to Stake 373 m on East Bank of Ruddy River thence down the meanders of said River to the Beginning State at said Bridge Together with all and singular the rights Membrs Hereditaments and appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Robert P.
