 City of Greenville viz No 1 Beginning on a stone
 Mc Kay Corner and runs S 82 1/4 E 95 ft to a stone near
 what is known as the public Spring thence S 12 3/4 E
 to a stone thence N 82 1/4 W 87 ft with a line to a stone
 on the Augusta R. thence N 2 3/4 E 35 feet to the Beginning
 Lot No 2 Beginning on a stone and runs with
