

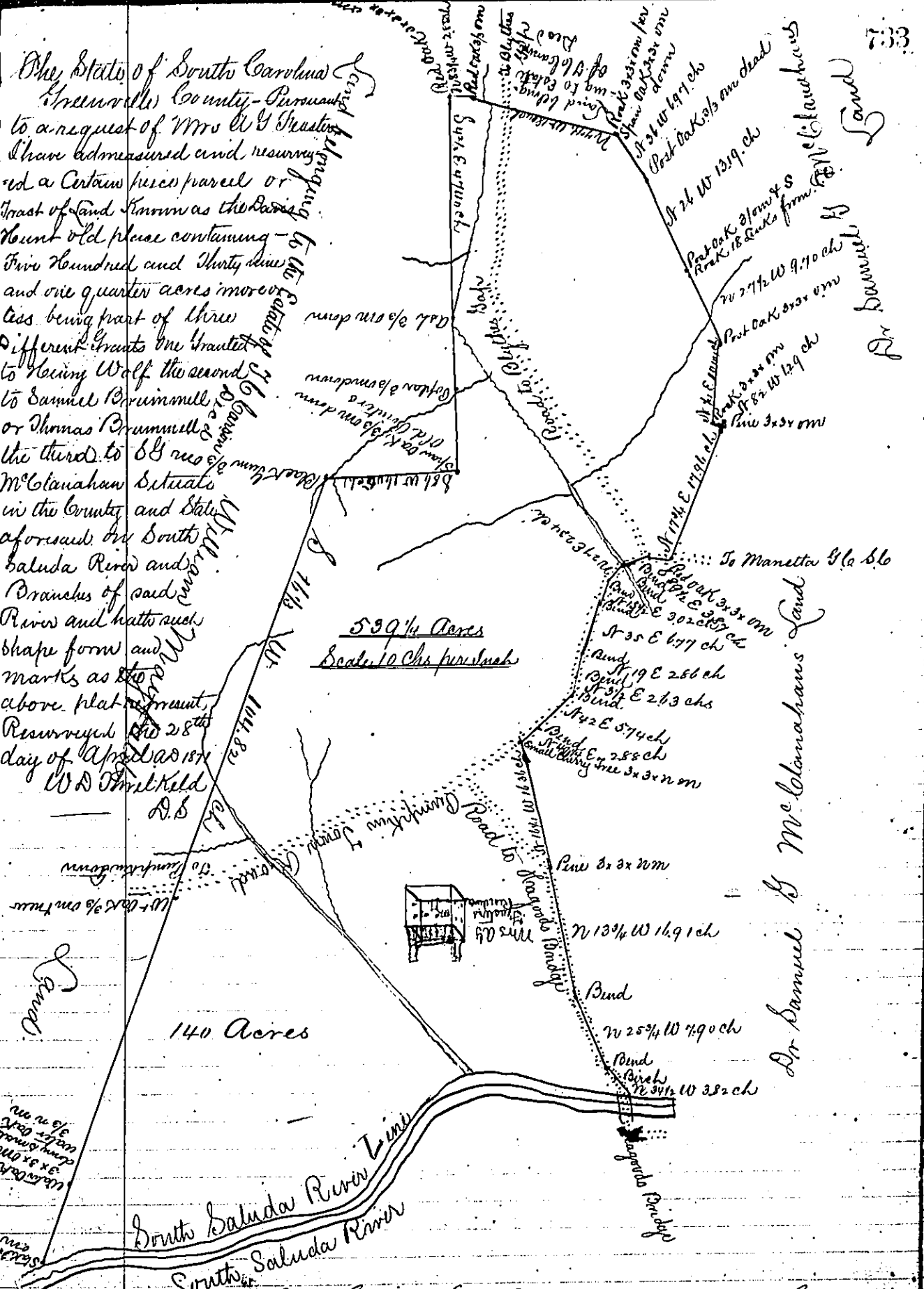

P. Moore's Acreage and Lot No 4 this day conveyed by the Commissioners to J. P. Coyle and Kurn as Lot No 5 and so described in said decree and return of the Commissioners in Petition together with all and singular the Remedial rights Privileges Incidents and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Lot belonging or in any wise appertaining and the revenues and remainders now issued and profits thereof and also all the legal rights title interest down possession property Rights claims and demands whatsoever both a Law and Equity of the heirs representatives of the said Court, C. Nowland decedent and of the parties to this suit and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof by force or under them or either of them to have and to hold the said Lot of Land with its Remedial privileges and appurtenances unto the said Sophia F.
