I, J. P. Dill Land I know all men by these presents that I Samuel A. Black of the County of Greenville & a State aforesaid & a field and formerly bound unto John P. Dill of the County and State aforesaid the sum of (\$250.00), Six Hundred and fifty Dollars Lawfull Money of the United States to be paid to the said J. P. Dill his Executors Administrators or assigns for which payment well and truly to be made myself my heirs Executors and Administrators and each of them jointly by this sealed with my Seal of Office dated the 11th day of July one thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy two Copie hereof of this obligance is such that if the said John P. Dill shall pay the said Samuel A. Blackman two thousand Dollars down and one thousand and twenty five Dollars on or by the twenty fifth of December one thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy three the same being for the purchase of one half of one acre of Land on which the said A. Blackman Mill is built on and one half the Mill for which the said J. A. Blackman binds himself in the above named sum of \$250.00 Six Hundred and fifty dollars to make a good and Lawfull title to the said J. P. Dill his heirs and assigns when the said payment is made the said Samuel A. Blackman further agrees to put the mill in good running order as soon as possible this the 11th day of July one thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy two in the Ninety seventh Year of Independence of the United States of America Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of

Paschal A. Ashmore Land I know all men by these presents that I James H. Sundersman of the District and State aforesaid in Consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Paschal A. Ashmore of the District and State aforesaid have granted Bargained sold and Release and by these presents do grant Bargain sell and release unto the said Paschal A. Ashmore one thousand acres more or less it being a tract of Land originally granted to John Tyler by his Excellency William Moultrie and a part of a tract originally granted to Robert Lillibrow by his Excellency William Moultrie and a part of a tract by Peter Sundersman and all of the above having County Law Grants and Black and the above said J. S. Lewis granted Bargain sold and Release by the said J. S. Lewis to the said Paschal A. Ashmore on the first day of Jan in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred and 1872 Since Beginning on a post oak on Fork Shoal Road thence S1/2 P to a post oak corner of Mrs. G. Black Land thence on a straight line to John Ashmore corner on a Branch near John Black's fence thence up said Branch to a Maple corner thence running that line to and old Road leading to John Black's old place thence a Long said Road to a short line running to a Conventional Stone on Fork Shoal Road thence a straight line to a Spanish oak or 2 old Meeting House Road thence on a straight line to a pine or oaks Road thence across said Road to Black corner thence a straight line to a pine corner near old Meeting House thence 10 Rods North thence 16 Rods West to a pine corner thence 10 rods to a post oak at Meeting house thence straight to a poplar in head of a Branch thence across said Branch to a Black Gum thence up said Branch to a white oak thence straight to oak in head of Branch near poplar thence straight to post oak on Fork Shoal Road to the Beginning corner together with all and singular the right title and Reclamations above mentioned unto the said Paschal A.
