 of South Carolina in consideration of one thousand and fifty five  
 Dollars to me paid by John J. Dillard of Greenville County  
 in the State of South Carolina have granted sold and  
 released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and  
 release unto the said John J. Dillard all those tracts or  
 parcels of Land Situate lying and being in Greenville  
 County and State aforesaid on the South East Side of the  
 road leading Greenville to Spartanburg Court House  
 and on both sides of a branch of Cotton River being  
 part of Lot No 2 of the Estate of Hugh Wainwright Esq of Greenville  
 County viz Beginning at a point near the Greenville and  
 Spartanburg road and running thence S 67° E 10.50 to a stone  
 31 thence N 50 3/4 E 17.27 to a stone 31 thence N 36 3/4 W 18.40 to a  
 stone 31 in the Greenville and Spartanburg road thence along  
 said road to the Beginning Containing twenty seven and  
 one half acres more or less which is more represented by  
 a plat of the same Together with all and singular the rights  
 Privileges Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said  
 premises before mentioned unto the said John J. Dillard his  
 heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself and my  
 heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever  
 defend all and singular the said premises unto the said  
 John J. Dillard his heirs and assigns against me and my  
 heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming  
 or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand  
 and seal this twenty fifth day of March in the year of our  
 Lord one thousand Eight hundred and sixty two and in  
 the ninth year of the Independence of the United States
