

Fowler and Vaughan and John A. Barker	Agreement	The State of South Carolina County of Greenville

This agreement made and entered into this day between Fowler and Vaughan of the first part and John A. Barker of the second part witnesseth as follows: The party of the first part are assignees of a mortgage from the estate of a tract of land belonging to the party of the second part and situated in the County of Edgefield and state aforesaid as will more fully appear by reference to said Mortgage. The party of the second part has agreed and hereby agrees to pay the sum of One Thousand Dollars to the party of the first part for their interest claim and estate in said Mortgage, four hundred and seventy Dollars in Cash to day and the balance Two Hundred and thirty Dollars on the 21st day of November next upon the payment of the last mentioned sum of money (\$5.30) the party of the first part agrees to assign and transfer the said Mortgage to John A. Barker the party of the second part - If the party of the second part fails to pay said sum of Two Hundred and thirty Dollars on the first day of November next then the party of the first part shall be released from all obligation to transfer said Mortgage as specified above.
