Bennett	Mortgage	<p>The State of South Carolina Greenville County This Indenture made the thirteenth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and seventy two between John T Bennett of Greenville County and State aforesaid of the one part and Thomas Thomason of the same place of the other part Witnesseth Whereas the said Thomas Thomason stands indebted to the said John T Bennett by sealed note to be paid the Twenty Fifth December next for seventy seven Dollars Cash the second note for three Bales good Cotton weighing Twelve Hundred pounds to be paid by the first November 1873 the third for twelve hundred pounds good lint Cotton to be paid by the first November 1874 and the fourth for one Bale good Lint Cotton weighing four Hundred and fifty pounds to be paid by 1st November 1875 All the Cotton to be delivered at Thomas Colson's Gin, Now This Indenture Witnesseth that the said Thomas Thomason for and in consideration of the Premises aforesaid and also in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars to the said Thomas Thomason by the said John T Bennett in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents have granted bargained sold and released and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John T Bennett all that certain piece parcel and tract of land situate in Greenville County and State aforesaid on Head Waters of Cripps Creek of Reedy River adjoining lands of the said Thomas Thomason James Ashmore Henry Brazure Henry Cox and W A Jennings Containing Sixty and one half Acres more or less being a part of the Robert Thomason Tract of land Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John T Bennett his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said the said premises unto the said John T Bennett his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every</p>
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
