Ligo Hargley praying that a certain Mortgage which John P. Hillhouse held against Robert Hawthorn & B. Ligo Hargley And the Cause being at issue before the Honorable Court aforesaid Come on to be heard on the day of in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and when the said Court after full hearing thereof and matters deliberation in the premises did order adjudged and decree that the said Tract of land should be sold at Public auction by the Sheriff of Greenville County South Carolina on the terms and for the purpose mentioned in the decretal order in the said Cause as by reference to the same in the registry of said Court will appear And the said John L. Southern as Sheriff as aforesaid having duly advertised the said Tract of land for sale by Public outcry on the third day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and seventy two did then openly and publicly and according to the custom of auctiores sell and dispose of the said Tract of Land as below ascended unto the said Mrs. Patsy Farr the wife of Bayles Farr for the sum of Thirteen hundred Dollars she being at that time the highest bidder for the same Now therefore this Deed is made witness that the said John L.
