In consideration of the benefit and advantages to accrue by the construction of the Atlanta and Richmond Air Line Railway as well as the receipt of five Dollars to me paid & made this day Bargains and sold and do hereby transfer and convey unto the Atlanta and Richmond Air Line Railway Company and its successors and assigns all the Land contained within one hundred feet in width on each side of the tracks or roadway measured from the center of any portions of the top of land passing through which said Railroad may by construction pass and operate the land hereby conveyed being cut off and a portion of a certain piece parcel and tract formerly belonging to J. D. Westmoreland and sold at Sheriff Sale and purchased by J. W. Grady as will more fully appear by reference to the Register of Married Companies wherein by land belonging to Boston and others To have and to hold said track or parcel of land unto said Atlanta and Richmond Air Line Railway Company for Real Road purposes forever in fee simple unless by deed and date the 13th day of August 1872
