Austin Andrew Hearbin and others beginning on a State 37<sup>th</sup> Thence N 7 1/2° E 11 to a Stone 31<sup>st</sup> Thence N 59° 10' 33" 38<sup>th</sup> Thence S 42 1/2° W 1/4<sup>th</sup> Thence S 59° 10' 34" to the Beginning Corner containing Forty acres more or less Together with all Land singular the Rights none has been determined and departures to the said premises belonging or in any said incident or appurtenance Or have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James W. Smith he his heirs assigns and administrators to have and to enjoy
