 whereof I do hereby acknowledge Have granted
 Bargained and Sold and by these presents do
 grant Bargain and Sell unto the said Elizabeth
 R. Johnson his and assigns forever the said
 tract piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances
 and all the estate right title and interest which
 the said B. R. Johnson of right had of in and to
 the same to have and to hold the said piece
 parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances
 unto the said Elizabeth R. Johnson his and assigns
 forever as fully and absolutely as I the said John
 L. Southern might could or ought to grant
 Bargain and Sell the same by virtue of the Statute
 aforesaid and the said writ of Executio Facias
 or otherwise In witness whereof I the said John
 L. Southern have hereunto set my hand and seal
 this first day of November in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two
