here granted bargain and sold and by  
these presents do hereby grant bargain sell  
and convey to the said Absalom Plythe as  
assignee by aforesaid all my right title &  
interest the same being an undivided half  
of in and to a certain tract or parcel  
of land in Greenville County State aforesaid  
lying on the North East of Saluda River  
known as the McCoy place tract and containing  
two hundred acres more or less adjoining  
lands of J. H. Chuland Williams less so much  
being the same tract conveyed to my Brother  
Edmund West & myself by our Father William  
West by deed bearing date the 3 of April 1866  
together with all and singular the  
rights & incidents hereunto and appertaining  
to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
incident or appertaining to have and to  
hold all and singular the said premises  
within mentioned unto the said Absalom  
Plythe as assignee as aforesaid his heirs  
and assigns forever And I do hereby bind  
myself my heirs Executors & administrators  
to warrant and defend all and  
singular the said premises unto the said  
Absalom Plythe as assignee as aforesaid  
his heirs and assigns against me & my  
heirs and all other persons lawfully
