G. W. Jones & Deed of the State of South Carolina  
 to Col. J. C. Jones

Know all men by these  
 presents that Georgiana W. Jones wife of Edwin  
 P. Jones Esq of Marlboro County in the State  
 aforesaid in consideration of Three Hundred  
 Dollars to me paid by Cash. to those of Marlboro  
 County in the State aforesaid. Who bought beyond  
 sold and released and by these presents do grant  
 bargain sell and release unto the said Cash. to  
 those all that tract of parcel of land situated lying  
 and being in the County of Marlboro and State aforesaid  
 being a part of the tract of land purchased by the  
 said Cash. to those from Charles J. Clifford Esq by deed  
 bearing date the 19 of July A.D. 1854 and being also  
 a part of the tract of land once conveyed by the said  
 E. P. Jones and Georgiana W. Jones his wife to  
 William T. Rowland which was the inheritance  
 of said Georgiana W. Jones bounded as follows  
 to wit Beginning at a stake or near the head  
 of what is generally known as the dry Branch  
 C. to those and P. A. Jones corner thence with E. P.  
 Jones land North 10° East twenty two chains & 70  
 links to a stake or on a stake thence N 65° West  
 six chains & forty links to a stake or on Monument  
 line thence with Rowland land South 43 1/2° West  
 chains & fifty links to a stake or on Rock thence  
 South 36 1/2° East with the out line of the original  
 survey to Rowland to the Beginning corner  
 containing about Eighteen acres (more or less  
 being the Northern or old field portions of the  
 said tract of land purchased by Cash. C. Cox  
 from C. J. Clifford) Together with all and  
 singular the rights incidents and appurtenances  
 appertaining to the said premises belonging  
 or in any wise incident or appertaining  
 to hold and to hold all and singular the  
 premises before mentioned unto the said  
 Cash. C. Cox his heirs and assigns forever  
 And I do hereby bind myself by this deed
