 the County of Beaufort and State aforesaid on the  
 banks of Saluda River near Cooley Bridge and  
 known as the Shockley Place adjoining lands of  
 Waddy Jordan Malinda Chapman and others being  
 the property of Severus Cooley at the time of his  
 death lying on the Cooley Bridge Road Together  
 with all and singular the rights incidents hereto  
 and appertinances to the said premises belonging
