 since the figures by me made by virtue of the said writ
 of Fieri Facias are before mentioned have been exposed to sale
 at public venting and purchased by William E. Corle
 of the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina
 for the sum of one Hundred Dollars this being the highest
 sum that was bid therefor Now know ye that I
 J. L. Southern Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of said writ
 of Fieri Facias aforesaid to me directed & directed as
 aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such case
 made and provided and for and in consideration of
 the said sum of one Hundred Dollars to me in hand
 paid or secured to be paid by the said Wm E. Corle
 the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge
 Have granted bargain and sold and by these presents
 do grant bargain and sell unto the said William
 E. Corle his and assigns forever the said tract piece
 and parcel of land with its appurtenances and
 the estate rights tenements which the said Edward
 Powell of right had of in and to the same to have
 and to hold the said piece parcel & tract of land
 with its appurtenances unto the said William E.
 Corle his and assigns forever as fully absolutely
 as the said John L. Southern might could or ought
 to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the
 Statute aforesaid & the said writ of Fieri Facias
 or otherwise in premises whereof I that said John
 L. Southern have receipt but my hand & seal the 5th
