 the said land was struck off for the sum of Twenty
 Two Dollars. Now this Court being satisfied that in
 consideration of the sum of Twenty Five Dollars to
 me paid and to be paid I have granted
 Benjamin Sola and Julia and by these presents do
 give Benjamin Sola and Julia with the said
 John P. Dill and his heirs assigns forever all that
 tract of land situated in said District on the west
 of Bedford Creek bounded by lands of P. Dill No
 100 & others and containing nearly two acres
 or less together with all other appurtenances thereto
 belonging and all the estate right title interest claim
 or demand which the said Edmund Dill owned
 at the time of his death had in or to the said land
 here and to hold the said tract of land together with
 all and singular the premises improvements and
 appurtenances to the said John P. Dill his heirs &
 assigns forever In witness whereof I the said J. Doughter
 as ordinary aforesaid have hereunto set my hand and seal
 of office this day and year above written signed
