Grady is in nowise to be responsible for the dower any one may be now or hereafter entitled in this Land to the said Caroline Huff or to any other person Together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Caroline Huff and to her heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Caroline Huff and to her heirs and assigns against me and my heirs & no other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
